## Vaccines and Your Fridge

	Store only vaccines in the fridge
<b>/</b>	Do not store anything else (ex: lunches, drinks or laboratory specimens) in the refrigerator with vaccines
<b>/</b>	Store vaccines on the middle shelves of the fridge  • group vaccines by product  • place short-dated product near the front (rotate stock)
	Use plastic baskets that are clearly labelled to separate vaccines which:  • allows for adequate air circulation • decreases vaccine use error • increases efficiency when re-ordering vaccines
	Do not store vaccines in the door or in the bottom level (drawers) of the fridge
	No more the 50% of the internal volume of the fridge should be filled with vaccine
	Store full bottles of water (labelled "Do Not Drink") on empty shelves, on the bottom level and in the door of the fridge.  • This helps to maintain stable temperature if the fridge door is opened frequently or in the event of a power failure.
