It has not been possible to determine from the records searched at which Post he was for every year of his career. He was at Coococache in 1897 (D.38/55, p. 24), Kikendatch, 1899-1904 (D.38/55, fo. 24; D.38/57, #2006) and Weymontachingue, 1905-1907 (D.38/55, p. 24).

In 1899, when he was in charge of Kikendatch, he was described as "good natured...honest & upright in all his dealings....very well liked by the Indians of that Post..." (D.38/55, p. 24)

He was the son of Chief Factor Peter McKenzie. A record of ca. 1913 describes him as married with a family of six.
