- 1. BMTJC reserves the right to decline Applicants, to determine if products and services are eligible and to determine the scope of assistance.
- 2. The Applicant indemnifies BMTJC from any injury that may arise from negligence on the part of the Applicant.
- 3. Support under this program will not exceed \$2,000 per supported visit for Manitoba businesses applying.
- Payment Within <u>30 days</u> after the buyer visit, the Applicant must submit by email to BMTJC (<u>ecdevprogram@gov.mb.ca</u>) their claim form with applicable proof of payments for Eligible Expenses claimed along with the Evaluation Form.
  - a. Upon receipt of all required documentation, a program administrator will arrange a postevent meeting to review the Evaluation Form. After the meeting, reimbursement will be issued by sending a cheque or EFT in Canadian dollars. All reimbursements will be made out to the Applicant.
  - b. If the Applicant is unable to meet the conditions and timelines noted above, then they will be considered in default of the IBP, eligibility will be rescinded, and reimbursement will not be issued.
