22.1 RESOLVED that there be granted to HER MAJESTY a sum not exceeding ONE MILLION, ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-SIX THOUSAND, SEVEN HUNDRED DOLLARS for STATUS OF WOMEN:

for the fiscal year ending the 31st day of March, 2000.

22.2 RESOLVED that there be granted to HER MAJESTY a sum not exceeding TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND, SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS for STATUS OF WOMEN:

AMORTIZATION OF CAPITAL ASSETS..... \$25,600.00

for the fiscal year ending the 31st day of March, 2000.
