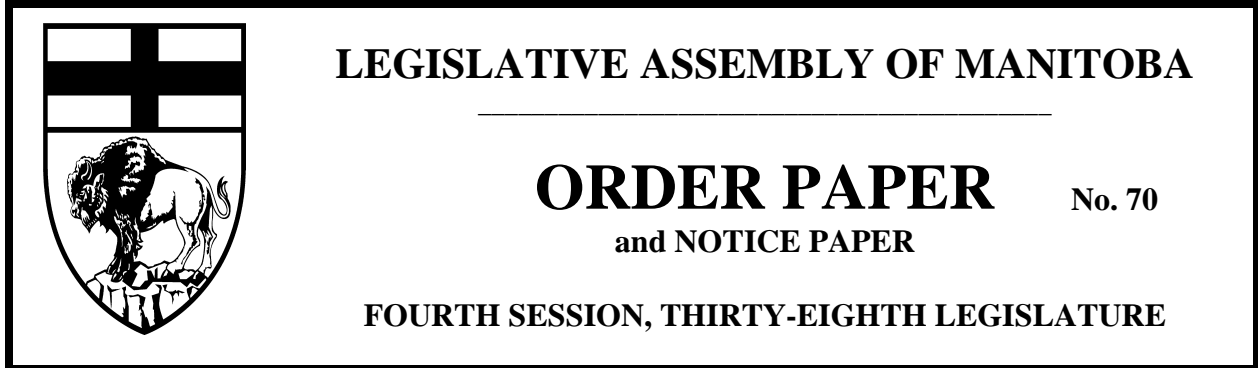

7. WHEREAS Hometown Manitoba Program is an initiative launched in the spring of 2003 as part of the Rural Economic Development Initiative that provides financial support for rural and northern community enhancement projects; and

WHEREAS Hometown Manitoba is a partnership involving the province, smaller communities, non-profit organizations and businesses wanting to improve the physical appearance of their communities; and

WHEREAS the program supports community-driven projects that advance community identities, build community pride and citizen involvement, and enhance the appearance and use of community gathering places and buildings in the ‘main street’ area of rural and northern communities; and

WHEREAS the physical enhancement of community main streets can encourage economic and social sustainability that build community pride and citizen involvement while promoting the use of local products, services and talents; and

WHEREAS in its first year Hometown Manitoba supported 176 upgrading and beautification projects worth more than \$300,000, and over the next year more than 190 community-improvement projects will share over \$350,000 in provincial funding; and

WHEREAS combined contributions in the first 2 years of this program are approximately \$2.5 million worth of structural and beautification improvements throughout the province; and

WHEREAS ongoing community pride and increased tourism are added benefits of this program

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Assembly of Manitoba congratulate the communities and volunteers for their involvement and efforts in building stronger communities and increasing community pride; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Assembly of Manitoba urge the Provincial Government to consider continuing to invest in rural and northern communities through such initiatives as the Hometown Manitoba program.
